1. <u>Call to order, roll call, and announcements</u>. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Commissioner Rutkowski announced that he will be resigning his commission after the July 11 meeting.

2. <u>Opportunity for public to address the Board on non agendized items</u>. No Public

3. <u>Approval of the minutes of the May 9 regular meeting</u>. A MOTION WAS MADE BY BROWN, SECONDED BY DAY TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE MAY 9, 2018 REGULAR MEETING. MOTION PASSED 4 IN FAVOR. COMMISSIONER BEVERIDGE ABSTAINED.

 - A. <u>Volunteer's Report</u>. Volunteer Chris Klein, president of the Firefighter Association, reported that the food truck at the fishing opener was successful. Four scholarships were awarded to graduating high school seniors. The station will hold an open house on July 4 starting at 12:30. Volunteers are needed to participate in the 4th of July parade.
 - B. <u>Report on Current Fire Department Activities, Assignments and Schedule for</u> <u>potential Board direction</u>. 12 calls, 6 medical, 5 TC, 1 public assist.
 - C. Long Range Planning Discussion.

- (a) <u>Personnel</u>. Volunteers will rotate between Chief and captains in training. They will be asked to sign up for rotations.
- (b) <u>Airport</u>. Chief will meet with Town of Mammoth Lakes inspector and enforcer to inspect the hangers.
- (c) <u>Geothermal</u>. No news.
- (d) <u>Station Maintenance</u>. Chris Klein installed the new TV. Ice machine needs fixing. Nathan will be changing all lights to LED. Chief will follow up on locating the new shredder. New bathroom door has been installed.
- (e) <u>Vehicle and Equipment Maintenance</u>. 3200 needs maintenance and tuneup. New Expedition, 3201 has been delivered. Needs light bar and graphics. Old 3201 will be transferred out. 3230 needs tires and rims. 3281, new water tender, needs to go to Reno for maintenance.

12. <u>Adoption of the 2018/2019 fiscal year budget</u>. Motion made by Commissioner Brown and seconded by Commissioner Rutkowski to approve the 2018/2019 budget totaling \$328,238. Motion passed 5-0.
